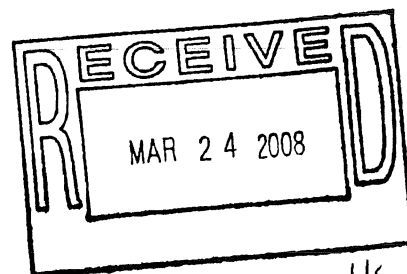

**FINAL JUDGMENT AWARDING PLAINTIFF ANGELA P. WILLIAMS
ATTORNEY'S FEES, COURT COSTS AND EXPENSES AGAINST EQUIFAX
INFORMATION SERVICES, LLC**

THIS CAUSE came to be heard upon Plaintiff's Motion for Attorney's Fees, Court Costs and Expenses. The plaintiff filed a complaint against the defendant for violations of the Fair Credit Reporting Act and plaintiff prevailed on her claims when a jury found that plaintiff suffered damages due to defendant Equifax Information Services, LLC's negligent and willful failure to comply with the Fair Credit Reporting Act ("FCRA"), 15 U.S.C. § 1681 et seq., awarding plaintiff \$219,000 in actual damages and \$2.7 million in punitive damages. The Court has considered the evidence presented and the Court file and having considered arguments of counsel, the Court makes the following finding of fact and conclusions of law:

1. The Court finds plaintiff is entitled to her attorneys fees and costs, pursuant to 15 U.S.C. §§ 1681n-o. The Court finds plaintiff is also entitled to reimbursement of certain expert witness costs under Fla.R.Civ.P. 1.390(c).

2. The Court awards plaintiff her attorney's fees of \$ 495,500⁰⁰, and costs and expenses of \$ 9,116⁰⁰.
